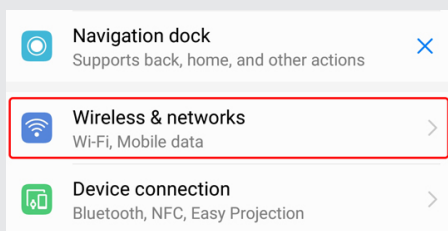


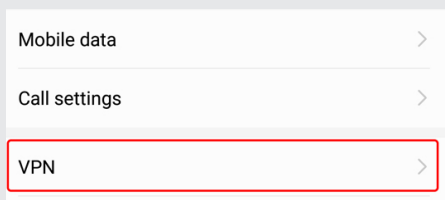
SETTING UP A VPN ON AN ANDROID DEVICE

This guide covers Samsung, Google, Huawei, Xiaomi, Sony etc. Before setting up a VPN you will need to know your login details and the type of VPN you want to set up.

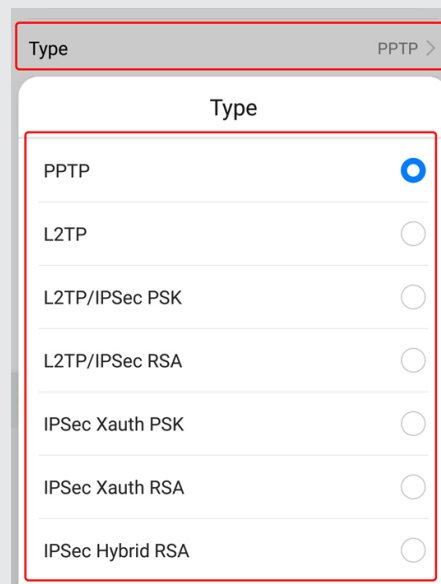
1. Go to **'Settings'**
2. Click **'Wireless and Networks'** then select **'VPN'**



3. On some Android devices there will be two options, you want to select **'Basic VPN'** then **'Add VPN'**



4. Name the connection and choose the type of connection (**IKEv2**, **IPSec** or **L2TP**)



5. Enter the VPN's server address. Click **'Save'** and your VPN should be up and running

You can add as many VPN connections as you like. In the **'Basic VPN'** section you can enable **'always-on VPN'**. This means network traffic will only be allowed through if you are connected to a VPN. If you have a Nexus device with Android 5.1 or a Google Pixel, you can use the **'WiFi Assistant'** which is basically a built in VPN. It's found in **'Settings'** then **'Networking'**. Here you can enable the WiFi Assistant and enable or disable **'Manage Saved Networks'** meaning it will automatically connect to networks you have used before.
