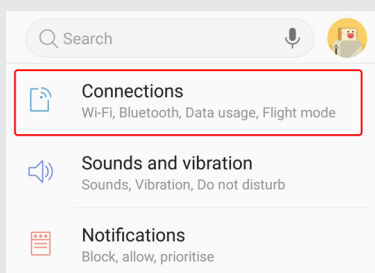


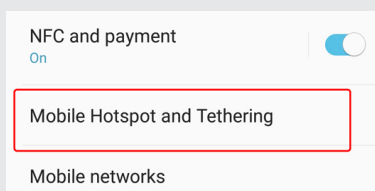
SETTING UP A WIFI HOTSPOT ON AN ANDROID DEVICE

This guide covers all Android devices such as Samsung, Sony, Huawei, Google, Xiaomi etc. Each device may differ slightly with different names and layouts.

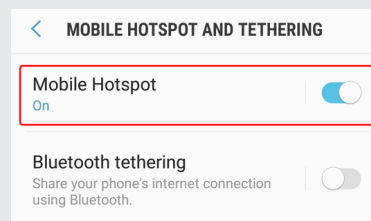
1. Bring up the menu and select **'Settings'** and click the button that brings up your WiFi and networks. It may be called something like **'Connections'**



2. Open the **'Mobile Hotspot & Tethering'** options



3. Turn on the **'Portable WiFi hotspot'** by selecting the tick next to it, or sliding the bar to on. This will now be a publicly available WiFi hotspot. To connect to it, users must know the password first, click **'Personal Hotspot'**



4. Click on **'Portable WiFi hotspot settings'**. Here you can change the password, security level, network name and manage users connected wirelessly to your phone
