

HOW TO MANAGE COOKIES WITH CHROME ON AN ANDROID DEVICE

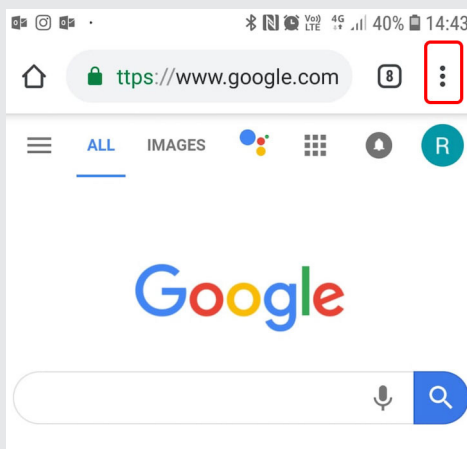
Follow this guide to clear, block and allow cookies on the Chrome app using an Android device. This guide covers devices such as Sony, Samsung, Google Pixel, Huawei. There may be slight variations of each step depending on the device.

Quick overview:

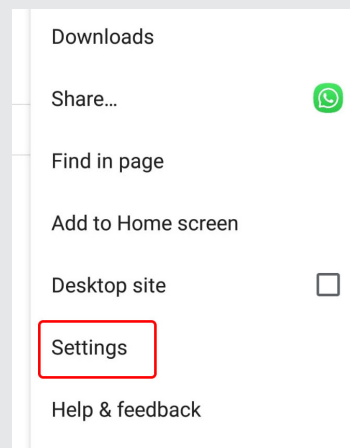
First-Party Cookies are created on the site you are using. Third-Party Cookies are created by other sites. For example, sites that own some of the content such as ads or images.

Clearing Cookies:

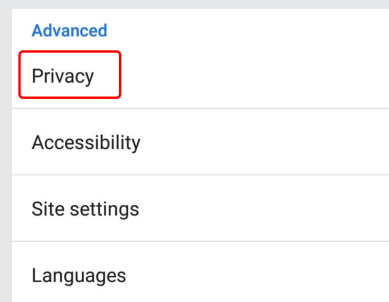
1. Using the Google Chrome app, click the three dots on the right of the address bar to open the menu



2. Click on 'Settings'

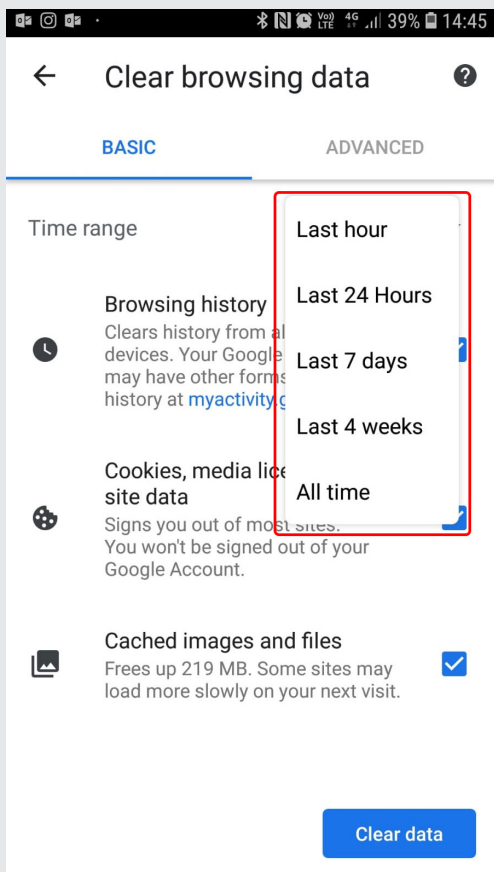


3. Select 'Privacy'

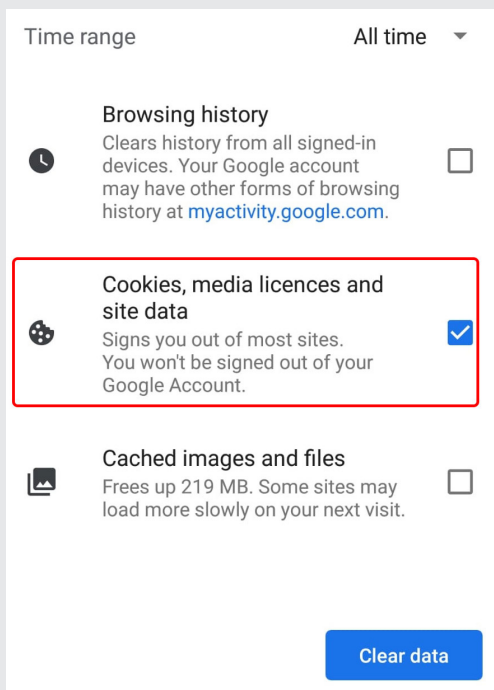


4. Pick the 'Clear Browsing Data' option
5. Select a time range such as 'All time' or 'Last hour'

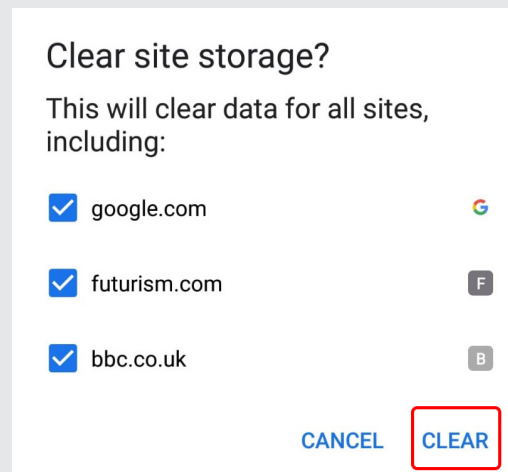




6. Tick the 'Cookies, media licenses and site data' box and untick the rest



7. Tap 'Clear Data'
8. Confirm this by pressing 'Clear'



Allowing and Blocking Cookies:

1. Using the Chrome app, click on the three dots to the right of the address bar to open the menu
2. Pick the 'Settings' option
3. Select 'Site Settings'
4. Tap on 'Cookies'
2. Turn the cookies 'On' or 'Off'
